Kellogg's Breakfast Club Grants – Indices of Deprivation Information

To check if your school is in an area which is classified as falling in the 10% of most deprived areas according to the Index of Multiple Deprivation, please click the appropriate link and follow the instructions below.

If your school is in **England**:

- Follow this link http://dclgapps.communities.gov.uk/imd/iod_index.html
- In the top right, click on '2015 Map= On' to change to 'Off'. This will remove the map and only the 2019 map should now be visible.
- Enter your postcode into the box in the top right-hand corner and choose the correct postcode from the drop-down list (do not enter your postcode and click enter as this will not work).
- The map will zoom in to your location and bring up a series of data on the right. The top paragraph will tell you the ranking of your school's postcode in the Indices of Deprivation. If it lies in the top 10% it will say 'This is amongst the 10% most deprived neighbourhoods in the country.'

If your school is in Northern Ireland:

- Follow this link <u>https://deprivation.nisra.gov.uk/</u>
- Enter your postcode into the box at the bottom of the page and click search.
- On the right-hand side in the middle you will see 'Deprivation Rank' with a number below it

 if this number is 89 or below, the postcode falls in the 10% of most deprived
 neighbourhoods.

If your school is in **Scotland**:

- Follow this link http://simd.scot/2016/#/simd2016_10pc/BTTTFTT/9/-4.0000/55.9000/
- **Either** zoom in on the map to your location. If your street is highlighted in red your school is in an area which falls in the 10% of most deprived neighbourhoods.
- **Or** in the middle box on the left-hand side, enter your postcode and click 'go'. Near the top of the large box on the right-hand side you will see 'Decile' followed by a number. If the number is 1, your school is in an area which falls in the 10% of most deprived neighbourhoods.

If your school is in Wales:

- Follow this link <u>https://wimd.gov.wales/?lang=en</u>
- Enter your postcode into the box near the top and click enter on your keyboard (at the time of writing the search button was not working, this may change over time).
- A pin for your postcode will appear on the map, click on the area of the pin and a box will appear in the bottom right-hand corner. This box shows you the ranking for your area. If the number is between 1 and 191, your school is in an area which falls in the 10% of most deprived neighbourhoods.
