

Kellogg's Breakfast Club Grants – Indices of Deprivation Information

To check if your school is in an area which is classified as falling in the 10% of most deprived areas according to the Index of Multiple Deprivation, please take a look at the instructions below and follow the appropriate link.

If your school is in England:

- Please use the following link: http://dclgapps.communities.gov.uk/imd/iod_index.html
- In the top right corner, click the button reading “on” next to the text that says “2015 Map” and turn it off. This will remove the 2015 map, leaving only the 2019 map visible.
- On the right-hand side of the map, there is a tool bar with a pin icon at the top. If you hover over this with the cursor, it should say “select location”. Click this icon.
- Enter your postcode into the search bar and select your postcode from the drop-down list - pressing enter to search doesn't work for this tool.
- The map will then pin your location, bringing up a series of data on the right. If your school is located in an area classified as the top 10% most deprived, the text will say **“this is amongst the 10% most deprived neighbourhoods in the country”**.

If your school is in Northern Ireland:

- Please follow this link: <https://deprivation.nisra.gov.uk/>
- Enter your postcode into the search bar at the bottom of the page and press “search”.
- Under the title “Multiple Deprivation Measure”, you will see a scale named “Deprivation Rank”. If your rank is **89 or below, the postcode falls in the 10% of most deprived neighbourhoods**.

If your school is in Scotland:

- Please follow this link http://simd.scot/2016/#/simd2016_10pc/BTTTTT/9/-4.0000/55.9000/
- On the left-hand side, look at the box titled “1. Map Chooser” and select “2020”.
- Then, via the middle box on the left-hand side, titled “2. Area Finder”, enter your postcode into the relevant search box and then click the “go” button.
- Look at the large box to the right of the map, named “Current Data Zone”. **You should see the word “Decile” followed by a number. If this number is 1, your school is in an area which falls in the 10% of most deprived neighbourhoods.**

If your school is in Wales:

- Please use the following link: <https://wimd.gov.wales/>
- Enter your postcode into the box near the top and click search.
- A red circle will appear on the map, pinning the location of the postcode. Click on this and the area should then be highlighted in red.
- A box will then appear in the bottom right-hand corner, this shows you the ranking for your area. If the number is **between 1 and 191**, your school is in an area which falls in the 10% of most deprived neighbourhoods.
